More Than \$350,000 in Grants Awarded to Salem Catholic Schools

The Salem Catholic Schools Foundation recently awarded \$354,000 in grants, which Foundation President Kevin Mannix mailed and or hand-delivered recently to four Salem-area Catholic Schools. The grants were awarded to St. Joseph School, St. Vincent de Paul School, Queen of Peace School and Blanchet Catholic School.
