



The 3A Oregonian Cup Winner:  
**Blanchet Catholic School!**

Blanchet Catholic School has been named the OSAA Oregonian Cup winner for the 2014-2015 school year in the 3A classification. This is the first time in school history that Blanchet Catholic School has won this prestigious award.

The Oregonian Cup award is the highest award the Oregon School Activities Association gives out. This award is given to schools who possess excellence in academics, activities and athletics throughout the school year. The Oregonian Cup trophy will be presented to the school at an assembly in the Fall.

Blanchet received 2,412.5 points during the school year. St. Mary's of Medford was second with 2,305.
